SATURDAY 20 JUNE

Get ready to blast off... as the Big Bang Boogie lands in our community! Join the community flash dance to get Parade off to a high stepping start and set off with our Opening Parade, making your way from East Point Pavilion to the Sunlight Stage where the Festival kicks off!



12:00 – 21:30

Be on the beach from noon till nightfall for an inspiring first day of our free summer solstice spree. With a packed programme of music, performance, workshops, talks, creative experiences and family-friendly activities spread across the Festival.

21:30 – 02:00

As our programme on the beach winds down, the Festival moves to venues around Lowestoft. Check out our ticketed Sundown Events at newly opened The Venue at Claremont Pier, The Seagull Theatre, East Point Pavilion, Royal & Norfolk & Suffolk Yacht Club and St Peter & St John Church – all just a short walk from the Festival site.

MOON WALK & BIG BANG BOOGIE!

This summer we're celebrating the 13 Moons which will be gracing our skies this year.

Parade is the culmination of our work with local community groups, in-house school workshops, assemblies, and public sharing sessions, which are delivered in partnership with CEFAS and Space East. It'll be out of this world!

How & When to Watch the Parade

Parade starts at East Point Pavilion on Saturday 20 June at 11:00 with an exciting community dance (keep an eye on our social media for hints on how to join in) and then we walk and strut down the sea front to the beach where it will open the festival's main Sunlight Stage at 12:00

Catch the parade anywhere along the route, but we recommend finding a spot somewhere between East Point Pavilion and Claremont Pier and join on the end!

Accessibility

The parade route from East Point Pavilion to Claremont Pier is entirely step-free and wheelchair accessible. From Claremont Pier, the parade goes down a short, steep slope onto the lower seafront promenade (Jubilee Parade), where it continues along flat paving until the main Sunlight Stage.

The final section of the parade route goes across the sand of South Beach. While this section is not wheelchair or buggy accessible, the parade will be visible from Jubilee Parade.

KEEPING CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE SAFE

It's important that everyone has a fun and safe experience at First Light, so we have put together some useful tips to support you and your family during your visit.

Wristbands

If you are attending the festival with children and young people, make the Kids Hub in the Cosmic Pirates Zone your first stop to pick up a wristband and write your contact number on it. Should you become separated this will help us to reunite you quickly.

Agree a meeting point

Visit it first together so you know exactly where to meet should you become separated.

Lost Children

If you do become separated from your child, inform a member of staff immediately. We have trained staff and procedures to help find them. Over the weekend point out 'Safe Adults' – festival staff, volunteers, security, first aid, and police, to your child/ young person so they know who to approach if they need help.

Teens and Young Adults

First Light can be an exciting first festival experience for young people, however they can easily become vulnerable due to drink and drugs. Its important to plan with parents and friends on how to stay safe, get a wristband too, and our roving festival pastoral team are here to help.

The festival can be a loud and overwhelming place, if you're in need of a quieter moment or someone to talk to we recommend visiting

- Pakefield Pastures, located at Pakefield Church
- Soul Space, located in the Wellbeing Zone on the beach

Vertical Space is a free new zone for young people offering drop-in creativity, games, DJ sessions and activities on the beach.

Created from feedback from young people in Lowestoft, here you can create your own unique merchandise sweatshirt with our heat press in Merch Me Up, using First Festival designs from previous years; put a record on (and mix it) at the Drop in DJ sessions with Raving 4 a Reason; try out and experience new and popular games with Game Anglia, Norwich Gaming Festival and The Fort; and join in with workshops, quests, tournaments and table-top gaming with Skyward Fire Games.

If you're looking to push yourself to the max, head to 'Mussel Beach' where the team from Delta Fitness will challenge you to the max with strength, cardio and endurance competitions.

Vertical Space is built around what young people asked for — a safe spot to chill, a chance to get creative, and somewhere you can just be yourself.

DAWN - CELEBRATE THE SUMMER SOLSTICE

This year our Moon theme celebrates the 13 full moons of 2026. Our closest neighbour in the universe, the moon is our constant companion, whose light fires imaginations and drives scientific exploration. From our most easterly UK location in Lowestoft, we salute the power of the moon across our programme of music, ideas, visual art, dance, science, spoken word and community.

Dawn this year is a very special Solstice celebration with three new music works to herald midsummer, with **Jason Singh's Suraj**

(Punjabi for "Sun") an immersive, soundscape inspired by the morning raga Bhairav, a new work by **Tendertwin** that pays homage to Benjamin Britten's Lowestoft birthplace and **Shells and Bells**, a piece by our musician in residence **Steve Pretty** that brings shells into dialogue with the haunting resonance of **ship's bells**, blending two maritime sound worlds into something immersive, elemental and alive to the moment of sunrise.

SUSTAINABILITY

Our commitment to sustainability runs through everything we do from the programming, our décor – which we reuse each year - and our site.

We work with amazing partners who study the very bottom of the sea and the planets millions of light years away in our skies as well as looking at events and stories past, present, and future.

We strive to improve every year and want our audiences to actively engage with their environment and be part of positive change.

WASTE

The team at Suffolk Waste Partnership and East Suffolk Services work alongside us to help keep the beach and our site as clean as possible. This year we have more bins than ever, with additional glass, food and recycling bins around the site for the first time. Our mighty team of volunteers litter pick throughout the festival to ensure we leave no trace.



POWER

We've used zero diesel in our generators over the last 3 years, making the switch to HVO in 2023 and we're always on the lookout for new technology to help us push what we can achieve.

PRINT

Our printers nearby in Norfolk are committed to responsible print production. The print processes focus on reducing waste, improving energy efficiency, and using materials that minimise environmental impact. This publication has also been printed using vegetable-based inks.



TRAVEL

We actively encourage festival goers and our artists to travel to the festival via the most sustainable means possible. 42% of our audiences came on foot last year, more than ever, and over 20% came by train, bus or bike. Our travel partner Greater Anglia put on an extra train, and reported that more passengers from Beccles, Saxmundham and Ipswich attended the Festival than in previous years and that the number of passengers was nearly 100% more than in 2024. Most of our audiences are local with nearly 60% within 4 miles.
